The depiction of railways is erratic, there are 7 different forms on these maps, from (i)dash lines, (ii) sl (iii) sl.x hatched, (iv)dls x hatched, (v)treble lines, (vi)pair of dl, (vii)pair of dls x hatched. In addition the practice of Mss rail updating [by red sl] of these maps by Walker prior to sale in Atlas form means the source map is frequently in an earlier date state than the date of issue of the atlas, in the 1890s they even left space for Mss dating of the titlepage.
